



## **GTHS Community Fundraisers: How to Get Involved**

### **What Are Community Fundraisers?**

Community fundraisers (also known as third-party events) are events hosted by individuals or businesses outside of the Georgian Triangle Humane Society to raise money or collect items to support our mission.

### **Want to Host a Fundraiser? Here's How to Get Started!**

#### **1. Get in Touch**

Before finalizing your community fundraising event, reach out to our Annual Fund Manager at [events@gths.ca](mailto:events@gths.ca) or call 705-445-5204 x 220 for approval. We will guide you through the process and offer planning tips and resources.

#### **2. Important Guidelines**

- The community fundraising event must be organized by someone 19 years of age or older.
- All community fundraising events must be clearly promoted as independent from the GTHS.
- Community fundraising event organizers are responsible for all event costs. The GTHS does not cover any expenses related to community fundraising events.
- GTHS attendance at community fundraising events is entirely dependent on volunteer availability and is not guaranteed. GTHS adoptable animals are not always available and not guaranteed. Any GTHS participation must be agreed upon in advance by our team.

- Onsite community fundraising events at the GTHS: If you plan to host a community fundraising event at our Animal Centre, a GTHS staff member must be in attendance. Please note that staff availability may have an impact on your proposed event date.

### **3. Event Approval**

Once your community fundraising event is approved, we will guide you through the next steps.

### **After Your Community Fundraising Event**

We require organizers to follow up with us after their community fundraising event. We are grateful for every effort made on behalf of the GTHS, and your support helps us continue giving second chances to pets and people in need.
